The team is open to any Middle or High School student up to 18 years of age. Safety training is provided. No experience or equipment is necessary, students do not need to bring anything, we supply safety glasses, earmuffs or plugs, ammunition and guns.

Parents do not have to be members of WSA although they are welcome to join. Shooters are required to join WSA as Junior members for liability purposes. Training will be provided by NRA coaches using modern, 12 ga. shotguns. After your first lesson, you will shoot every night.

Registration will be held at the WSA Trap house on Thursday March 26, 2019 from 6:00 to 8:00 pm. The program will meet from 6:00 - 8:00 pm on the following Thursdays; April 2, 9, 16, 23, 30, May 7, 14, 21, 28.

In addition, shooters are invited to test their new-found skills against other junior shooters from surrounding clubs at both the Mass State Trap Shoot in June and the New Hampshire Shoot in July at Minuteman Sportsman's Association in Burlington MA. Additional information to follow.
